1. Annual General Meeting

The 2026 AGM took place on 28th May 2026.

The Committee was re-elected unanimously.

During the discussion on Traffic & Parking in the Triangle, concerns were expressed by residents that cars parked on the south side of Princes Road near the junction with Pinegrove were obscuring sightlines for those trying to exit Pinegrove.

TRG has written to Cllr Oliver to request that Surrey CC consider extending the double yellow lines at that junction to address this concern.

Pippa Graeme, one of the two councillors elected to represent Weybridge on the newly formed East Surrey Council kindly agreed to join us and shared her thoughts on how the new, very much slimmer representative body will operate across all the activities that are currently covered by both Surrey CC and Elmbridge BC.

This application for change of use of an existing commercial building to two residential units was [refused](#) by Elmbridge on 22nd May 2026.

One reason given the absence of provision for off-street parking.

In addition to TRG's, 18 objections were submitted as well as 9 submissions in favour of the application.
